

Park Usage Rules

Our community parks are for the exclusive use of High Plains Village residents and their guests.

- All posted rules and regulations must be obeyed.
- It is prohibited to ride or cause to roll or coast any skateboard, roller-skates, roller-blades or any other conveyance powered by human power other than on concrete sidewalks.
- No glass containers or bottles in the parks.
- No open flames (such as candles, tiki torches, etc.) or use of grills to build a bonfire. Grills are for cooking only.
- No stakes are to be driven into the ground more than 6" for any reason (irrigation lines are present), except as approved by the managing agent.
- No Dunk Tanks, Pony Rides, or other similar set-ups at the parks.
- Noise ordinance strictly enforced (amplifiers, stereos, etc.) by the Loveland Police Department. Violators may be ticketed, fined, or removed from premises at the discretion of the LPD.
- Pets must be leashed and under human control at all times. **Pet waste must be picked up by owner, but NOT deposited in picnic area trash cans.**
- Park hours are from sunrise to sunset.
- No use of firearms or fireworks.
- Park receptacles are not to be used to deposit individual/household trash or pet waste. If a private event is scheduled in the park, debris or trash must be removed from the site and deposited elsewhere. Pack your own trash from private events.
- The mutilation, through vandalism or alike, of community property (including trees/shrubs) is prohibited. Violators may be prosecuted and/or fined.
